

# Minor Eye Condition Service

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## Criteria for inclusion

Patient must be registered with a North Hampshire CCG GP practice or a patient from another participating CCG.

The following conditions (note this list is not exhaustive) may present to MECS. Patients must be managed or referred onward as appropriate, in a timely way, and within the scope and capability of the practitioner:

- Loss of vision including transient loss
- Sudden onset of blurred vision but always consider if a sight test would be more appropriate
- Ocular pain or discomfort
- Systemic disease affecting the eye
- Differential diagnosis of the red eye
- Foreign body and emergency contact lens removal (not by the fitting practitioner)
- Dry eye
- Epiphora (watery eye)
- Trichiasis (in growing eyelashes)
- Differential diagnosis of lumps and bumps in the vicinity of the eye
- Flashes/floaters
- Retinal lesions
- Patient reported field defects
